ISO 9001:2015

Major changes!

Draft International Standard (DIS) and Final Draft International Standard (FDIS) developed in May 2014

Issued in September 2015

New concepts such as risk-based thinking

ISO 9001:2000

Major revision!

The processes approach and system approach to management

Emphasis on management processes, understanding customer requirements and continuous improvement of processes to increase customer satisfaction

SO 9000:1987

The first international standard focusing on "Quality"

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Understanding ISO

ISO 9001 is a quality management system (QMS) standards adopted worldwide to assure consistency of product/ service quality and reliability.

Understanding ISO

What is Quality?

- Those product features that meet the needs and requirements of the customer
- Freedom from deficiencies and defects
- Conformance to standards


Goals of ISO 9001 Certification

- To demonstrate that the organization does have a management system conforming to the requirements of ISO 9001
- To show that the system is effective in achieving the desired outputs
 - "Consistent conforming products/ services"
 - "Enhanced customer satisfaction"

What is a QMS?

A system to establish <u>quality</u> <u>policy</u> and quality objectives, and to achieve those quality objectives.





Third Phase: Certification

Procurement of a 3rd Party CB

Initial Audit

- Stage 1: Document Audit
 - QMS document review
- Stage 2: On-site Audit
 - Verification of QMS implementation and its effectiveness

Surveillance Audits (Conducted annually)

- 1st Surveillance Audit conducted not later than 12 months after the last day of Stage 2 Audit
- 2nd Surveillance Audit conducted not later than 12 months after 1st Surveillance Audit

- Costing for QMS certification should be consistent with the mandays requirement of the IAF MD 5:2015 for Duration of QMS and EMS System Audit.
- As identified by the DAP, PhP25,000 is the present estimated cost per man-day.
- To know the no. of audits, find first the man-days by determining the no. of effective personnel [permanent and non-permanent (temporary, contractual, part-time and seasonal) who will be present at the time of audit] of the agency and applying its prescribed mandays (m) under the matrix of said MD.

Note 1: The numbers of personnel in Table QMS 1 should be seen as a continuum rather than a stepped change. I.e. if drawn as a graph, the line should start with the values in the lower band and end with the endpoints of each band. The starting point of the graph should be personnel of 1 attracting 1.5 days. See clause 2.2 for dealing with parts of a day.

Note 2: The CAB's procedure may provide for calculation of audit time for a number of personnel exceeding 10700. Such time should follow the progression in Table QMS 1 in a consistent fashion.

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Note 3: See also clause 1.9 and 2.3.

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Third Phase: Certification

Compute the cost of the certification as follows:

Possible Audit Stage		Total Man-days (m)
Initial Audit (Stage 1 and Stage 2)	:	m
1st Surveillance Audit (SA) (next year)	:	m/3 (round of to the next unit)
2 nd Surveillance Audit (next year after 1 st SA)	:	m/3 (round of to the next unit)
Total Audit Man-days	:	(m+m/3+m/3)
Cost per Audit Man-Days	:	PhP25,000
Total Cost of QMS Certification Audit	:	(m+m/3+m/3) x Php25,000

Third Phase: Certification

Example: Agency with an effective personnel ranging **from 876 to 1175**, the man-days of audit duration for a Department-wide certification [with 16 Regional Offices (ROs)] under Audit of Multiple Sites by Sampling, with 2 Auditors per site for a max of two (2) days:

Audit Stage		Computation	Total
Initial Audit (Stage 1 + Stage 2)	:	Per MD	13
First Surveillance Audit (SA) (next year)	:	13/3 = 4.3 rounded off to 5	5
Second Surveillance Audit (next year after 1st SA)	:	13/3 = 4.3 rounded off to 5	5
Total Audit Man-days	:	13 + 5 + 5	23
Cost per Audit Man-Days	:		P25,000
Total Cost of QMS Certification Audit	:	23 x PhP25,000	PhP575,000

Third Phase: Certification

For other expenses, use the applicable COA rates:

Transportation Expense = [(Airfare average of PhP10,000 round trip) x (2 pax) x (10 sites)] + [(Bus fare of PhP3,000/day) x (2 pax)]

Accommodation Expense = $(PhP3,000/day) \times (2 pax) \times (2 days) \times (13 sites)$

Incidental Expense = $(PhP300/day) \times (2 pax) \times (2 days) \times (13 sites)$


