Objectives

Republic Act No. 11055, also known as the “Philippine Identification System Act,” aims to establish a single national identification system to:



provide a
**valid proof of
identity** for all
Filipino Citizens



eliminate the need to
present other forms of
identification



Key Components

- **PhilSys Registry**
- **PhilSys Number (PSN)**
- **PhilID**



PhilSys Registry

- ▶ It contains the demographic and biometric data, and PhilSys Number (PSN).



Demographic Data

- Full Name
- Sex
- Date and Place of Birth
- Blood Type
- Address
- Filipino or Resident Alien
- Marital Status, Mobile Number and Email Address (all optional)



Biometric Data

- Front-facing Photograph
- Ten (10) Fingerprints
- Iris Scan



PhilSys Registry

- ▶ For children **below five (5) years old**, only the demographic information and front-facing photograph shall be collected.
- ▶ For children aged five (5) to fourteen (14) years, including those who have been registered at age four (4) or below, shall be recaptured at the age of fifteen (15).



PhilSys Number (PSN)

- ▶ A randomly generated, unique, and permanent identification number that will be assigned by the PSA to every citizen or resident alien upon birth or registration.



Deactivation of PSN

- Loss of Filipino citizenship or Resident Alien status
- Failure to submit to biometric capture at age five (5) or fifteen (15) who were initially registered
- Death of the Registered Person
- Upon request of the Registered Person
- In cases of fraud or identity theft, the PSA may also deactivate a PSN upon official investigation



Reactivation of PSN

- The PSN may be reactivated upon submission of satisfactory proof for its reactivation under the guidelines to be set by the PSA.



PhilID

- ▶ A non-transferable card that shall preferably be issued to all citizens or resident aliens registered under the PhilSys and is **permanently valid**.

Features

PCN, Full Name, Sex, Date of Birth, Place of Birth, Blood Type, Address, Marital Status, and Front-Facing Photograph
QR Code





Fees

FOR FILIPINO CITIZENS:

- **FREE** during initial issuance and renewal.
- **WITH FEES** for replacement due to loss, damage and change in entries.

FOR RESIDENT ALIENS:

- **SUBJECT TO FEES** during initial, renewal and replacement of PhilID.

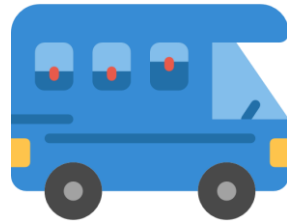


Registration Center (Types)



Fixed Registration Center

A registration center set up within the premises of PSA or partner agencies



Mobile Registration Center

A transportable registration center set up outside the premises of PSA or partner agencies.



Overseas Registration Center

A registration center set up within the premises of a Philippine Foreign Service Post or other registration centers that may be designated by the Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA) in coordination with PSA.



Registration Kits

- Laptop installed with configured registration system for biometric and demographic capturing
- Fingerprint scanner, iris scanner, document scanner, webcam, printer, tripod, and light booth





Registration Process

Who is eligible?

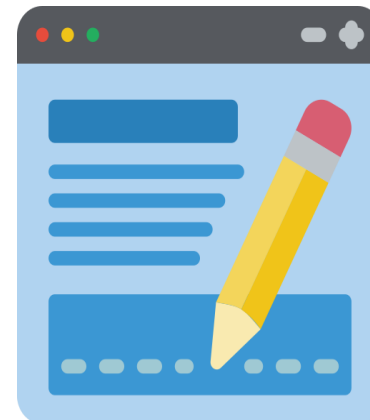
- Citizens living in the Philippines at the time of enrollment;
- Citizens living abroad at the time of enrollment; and
- Resident Aliens.



Registration Process

Documentary Requirements

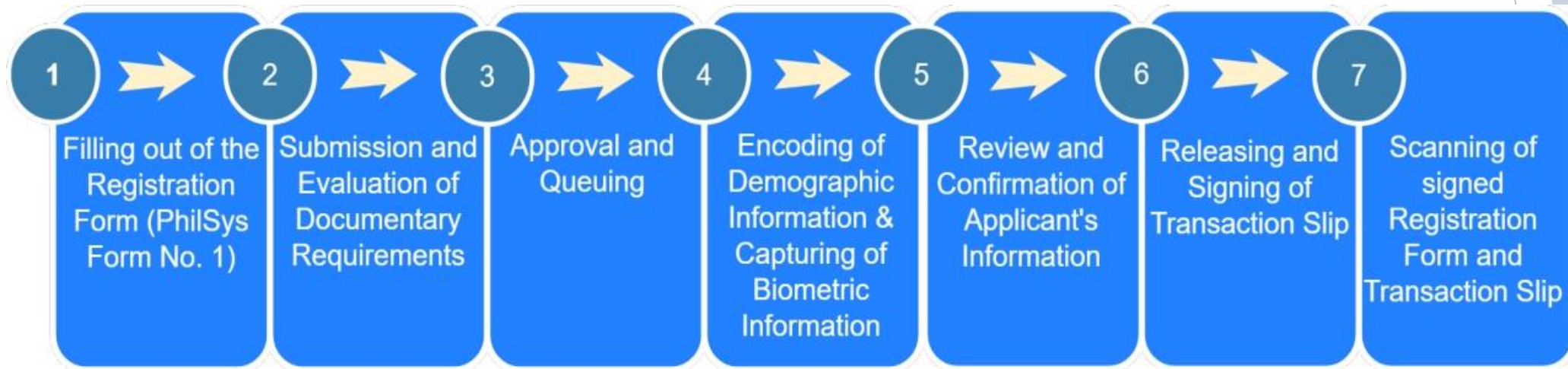
- **Duly filled-out PhilSys Form**
 - Registration Form (PhilSys Form No. 1)
- **Presentation of Supporting Document/s**
(e.g. PSA-issued Birth Certificate, Passport, UMID, Driver's License etc.)



Availability of PhilSys Forms:

- At the Registration Center
- Downloadable at the PhilSys Portal
- Encodable Online (Pre-Registration)

Registration Process



- For applicants who are unable to present any valid supporting document, he/she can be endorsed by a **Qualified Introducer**.
- An Introducer could be Tribal Chieftain/Leader, Barangay Official, Head of Institutional Population.

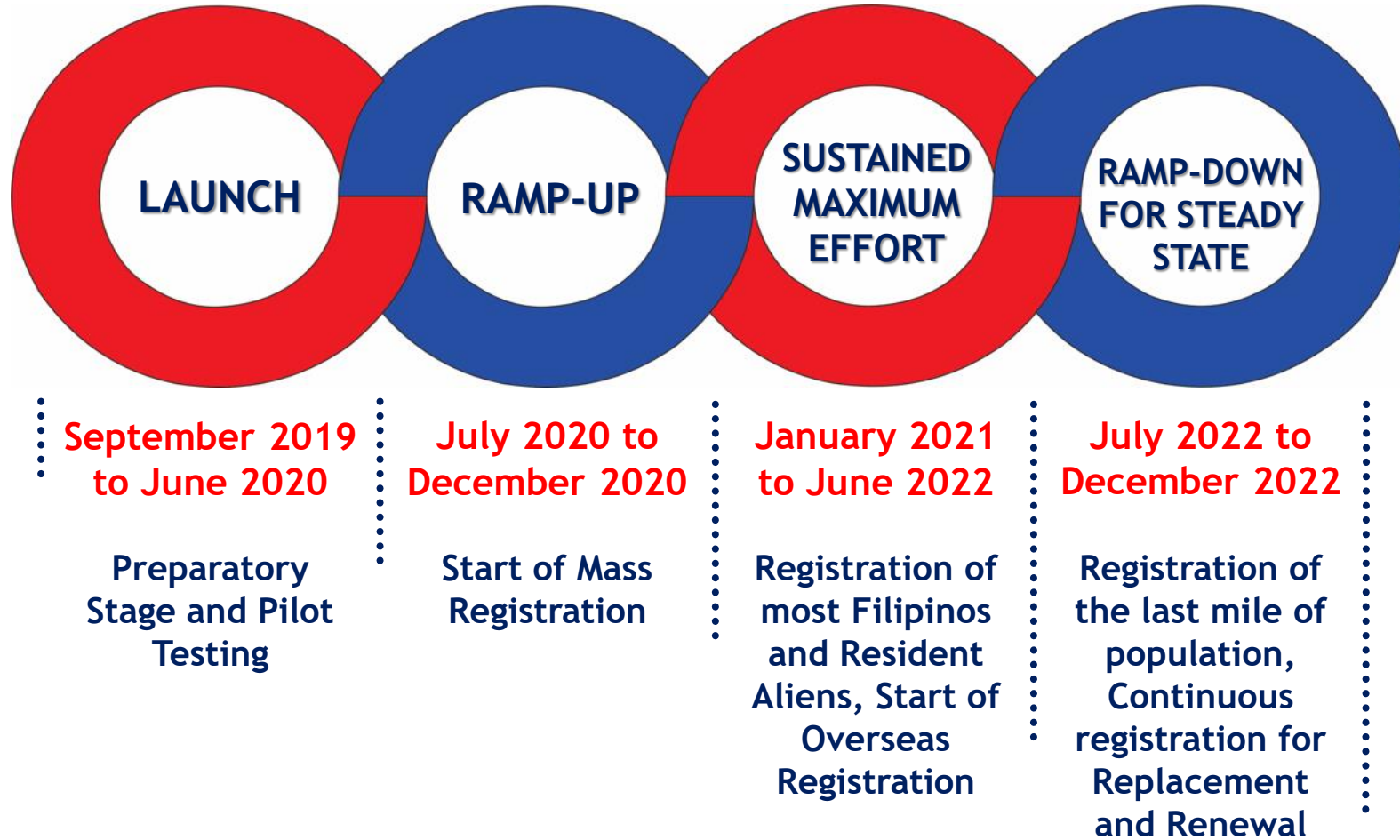


Registration Process

Post-Registration

- The applicant will be notified via SMS and/or e-mail as to the status of his/her application including the issuance of the PhilID.
- The PhilID may be picked up personally at the PhilSys Registration Centers he/she registered in or may be delivered to his/her present or permanent address.
- The PhilID may be replaced upon loss, damage or change of entries or renewed upon recapturing or updating of biometric information.

IMPLEMENTATION PHASES



Full registration of almost all Filipino citizens and resident aliens is targeted by 2022.

Authentication

Authentication

- It refers to the process of verifying, whether online or offline, the identity of an individual against the registry information in the PhilSys or PhilID.
- The PhilSys' main digitized process is through **authentication** facilitated by the PSN or PhilID.

Online

- the process by which the identity of an individual is validated real-time against the PhilSys Registry by the requesting entity through secured connectivity.

Offline

- the presentation of the PhilID and the matching of the data stored in the QR code will be used to validate the identity of the registered person for transactions and services.



Authentication

Methods

- PhilID/Mobile ID taken at face value (offline)
- Fingerprint, facial or iris 1:1 matching (online)
- One-time password (OTP) through SMS (online)
- Validation of Mobile ID (online)
- E-KYC, i.e. sharing limited demographic data and photo, as determined by law, following a successful authentication (online)

- Availing of UCT



- Loan application



- Membership registration
- Health claims

- Opening of bank accounts

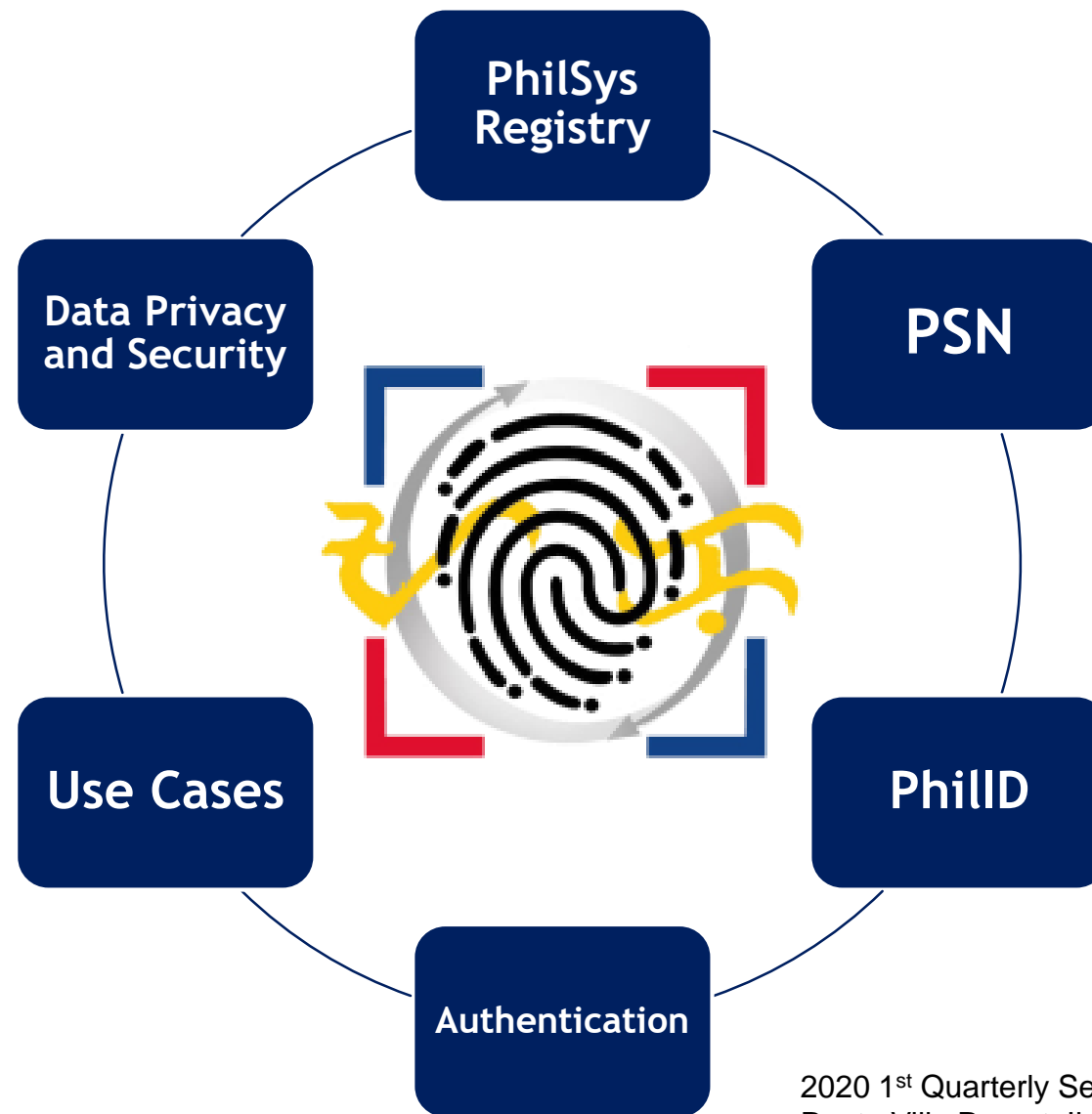
